If you do not receive a voter registration card in the mail within three weeks of mailing this application, call (202)727-2525, (866)328-6837 or 711 (TTY). If you are registering to vote in the District of Columbia for the first time and submit this application by mail, you may be required to provide identification that shows your name and current address the first time you vote in an election in the District of Columbia. Your mailed application must be received by the Board by the 21st day preceding the next election. After that date, you can register to vote in person at 1015 Half Street SE, Suite 750. You can register on the same day that you vote with valid proof of residence, but registering before you arrive at the polls will save you time.
